Well done Year 6!

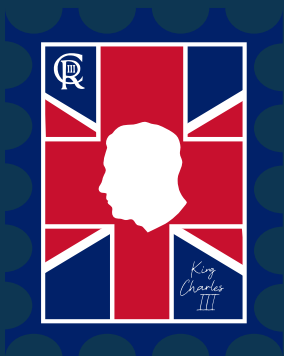


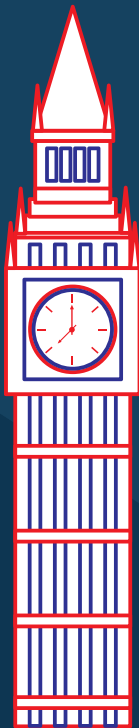


The Coronation of King Charles 3rd

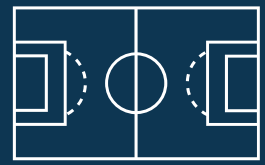
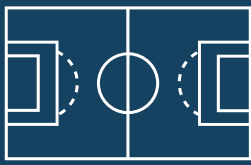

FixMyStreet is a website and app you can download to your phone; you can report any problems from fading yellow zig zags to broken kerbs and roads.

Log on or go to the app

Enter a nearby UK postcode or street name and area

Locate the problem on a map of the area

Enter details of the problem

They then send it to the council on your behalf

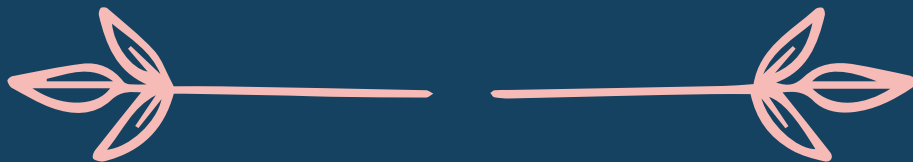
