Nursery Nature Walk

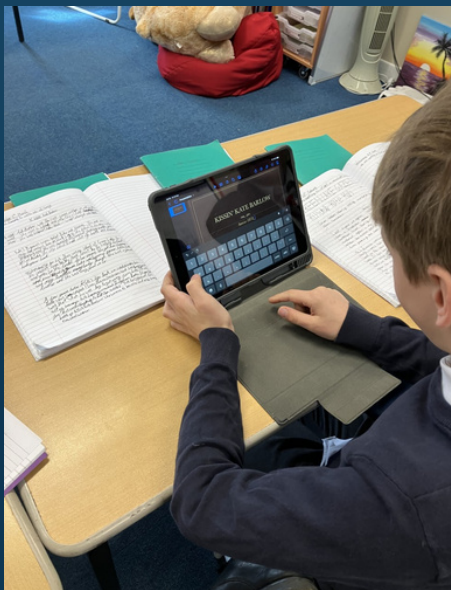
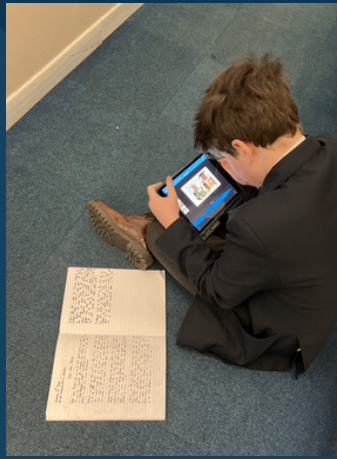

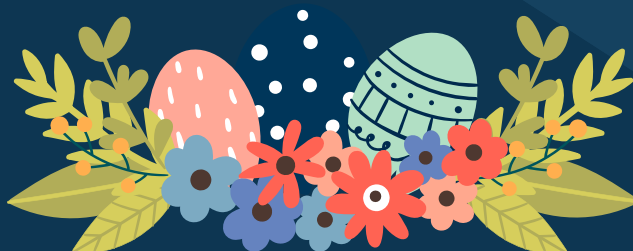
