All of the children will get to enjoy the library, each class will have a time slot every week. We hope they all love it as







If you follow us on Facebook, you will have seen the pictures of the new school library which was opened this week. It's a truly wonderful space for the children to enjoy for years to come and we're thrilled that we were able to provide the furniture and books with funds raised from last years fundraising efforts. One of our main goals is to raise money that can be put back into the school to benefit the children, and it's wonderful to see projects become a reality.

These positions will need to be filled at the AGM for the PTA to continue.

I have attached a brief document with more information about what is required from each of the roles but more than anything, what those involved in FoBM really need is a passion to want to make a difference and a can-do attitude. Everything else has a way of falling in to place if you're committed to making it happen. The roles aren't anything to be intimidated by and can definitely be learned 'on the job' (I speak from experience!). There will also be a full and thorough handover from the outgoing committee.



Open Evening for Year 7 Admission in September 2024 Thursday 21st September 2023, 16:30 – 19:30


