Subject: Year 6 Transition Days

14th June, 2025

Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you are all well and you and your child are looking forward to the beginning of a new and exciting chapter in your lives. We have been working hard with all our primary schools to ensure we have all the appropriate information to support the transition process.

This update is to give you all the information of the activities that will be taking place this half term.

Transition Days - Wednesday 2nd July, Thursday 3rd July and Friday 4th July -

We are eager to meet your children on the transition days and we have planned a range of lessons and activities to familiarise your child with their new environment and enthuse them about moving school. There is an expectation that your child will attend all three of these days. If they are unable to attend on the day, you must inform both us at Bradfield School on the number below and also your current primary school.

The aim of the transition days is to allow your child to meet other students in their form and year group and to have an experience of life at Bradfield. Students will be put in their form groups on the morning of Wednesday 2nd July. This information will not be shared beforehand. Your child will work in their form group for the 3 days and will experience lots of activities that will support a smooth transition.

Please note, the additional transition day on **Thursday 26th June** is aimed at children coming to us in small cohorts (ones or twos) from their primary school. If this applies to your child, you should receive separate information via your primary school or directly from Bradfield.

Practicalities for all Transition Days

Time 8:30am-2:45pm

- Arrival at Bradfield School from 8:00am and make your way to the Sports Hall. Students will be met outside by Bradfield staff and students, who will be easy to identify as they will be in high visibility vests.
- School buses can be used. You will need to provide your child's bus fare which is £1 each way. For the bus timetable, please refer to South Yorkshire Transport. Bradfield School – Transport Information
- Practical clothes should be worn as we will be doing a range of activities inside and outside – your child does not need to be in school uniform.
- Your child will need to bring a bag with them with a pen and pencil to support the activities.

Please ensure all clothes and bags are labelled.

- Please also pack a pair of gloves for the chilly activity the Science department have planned.
- Students can either bring their own packed lunch or have a school dinner. If they have a school dinner, we will add the cost of £2.88 to your account which will need to be paid in September when you receive the details for your parent pay account.
- Year 6 will finish at 2.45pm so staff can supervise them while waiting for a bus or for a lift. Students will be allowed to leave school site unsupervised unless you inform us of any concerns.

Please park outside of school to allow safe access is needed for disability drop off and pick up.
