Dear Parents and Carers,

As our Year 11 students move into the final phase of their secondary school journey, we would like to share some key upcoming dates and events. As stated in my letter before half term, our sole focus with Y11 is on helping students feel prepared, confident, and ready for their exams, while also celebrating their achievements and the contributions they have made to our school community.

Please find the key dates below:

- **Mock Results Day: Friday 6th March**
Students will receive their mock exam results in a manner similar to the official exam results day in August. The aim of this is to motivate and support students in prioritising their revision going forwards.
- **Written exams begin: Tuesday 5th May**
The first written exam is due to take place on Tuesday 5th May in Health and Social Care. From this date, we will be allowing Y11 students to come to school in non-school uniform. So that we can make sure we adhere to the JCQ exam regulations, please can we ask that students do not wear clothing with large front pockets, hoods or large amounts of writing on.
- **Beginning of Study Leave: Friday 22nd May**
Study leave will begin on this date, with students able to study from home from 1st June and only attend school for their exams. However, Y11 teachers will still be available in timetabled lessons for students to come into school and access help and support. There will be revision sessions directly before all exams both before and during exam leave. In the mornings this will run from 8am and in the afternoon these will run from 12:15. A timetable of these sessions will be shared closer to the exam season.
- **Leavers' Day: Friday 19th June**
A special morning to mark the end of students' time with us. Students are welcome to attend in fancy dress, but must ensure it is appropriate for the occasion. Further information on the arrangements for this will be shared nearer the time.
- **School Prom: Friday 3rd July**
A wonderful opportunity for students to celebrate together at the OEC. Details of this and costing have already been shared by Miss Lawton.

- **Official Exam Results Day: Thursday 20th August**

Students will be able to collect their results from school. There are 3 options when doing this:

1. **Collecting in Person:**

GCSE results will be available for collection between **9:00am-11:00am on Thursday 20 August 2026**, in the **Activity Studio**. To collect results, students must bring a valid form of **photo identification** (such as a passport or bus pass).

2. **Nominating Someone to Collect Results**

If students are unable to collect results in person, they may nominate someone else to collect them on their behalf. The person nominated must:

- **be over 18 years of age**
- bring their own **photo identification**
- sign for the results on behalf of the student

To nominate someone, you must email exams@bradfield.sheffield.sch.uk from your child's **school email account** before results day. Please include the student's full name, the name of the person collecting the results, and their relationship to the student. If you do not send this email, we cannot release results.

3. **Requesting your results via E-mail**

If you are on holiday for Results Day, you can request to have exam results emailed to your child's school email address. To submit a request, please email exams@bradfield.sheffield.sch.uk from your child's school email account with their full name, **before Results Day**. Unfortunately, we are unable to send exam results to any external email address (such as icloud, yahoo, gmail etc), **or to anyone other than the student.**

All Students should ensure they can access their school email account before they finish their exams.

On Results Day, we will begin emailing results from 9:00am. Please allow time for requests to be processed. Any results not collected on Results Day will be posted to the student's home address listed on the school database. We will send out further information regarding post results enquiries and services later in the summer term. Exam certificates are normally ready for collection from school in early November, we will contact you again later in the year with further information.
