Pupil Transition - Feedback



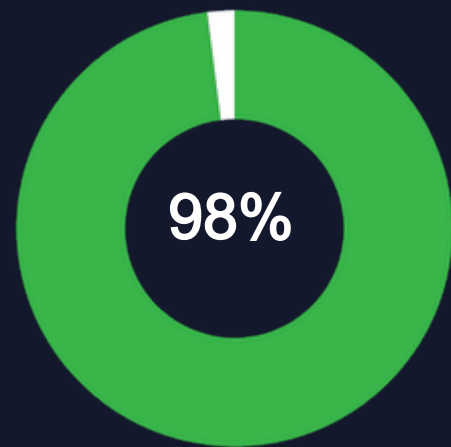

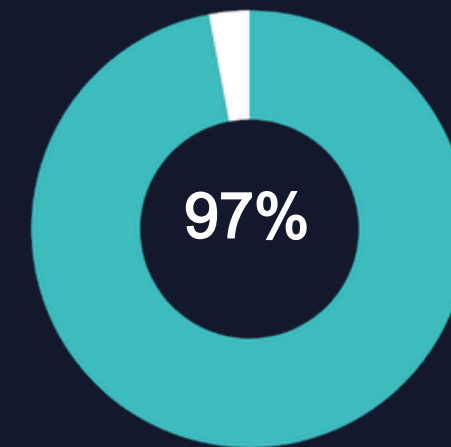

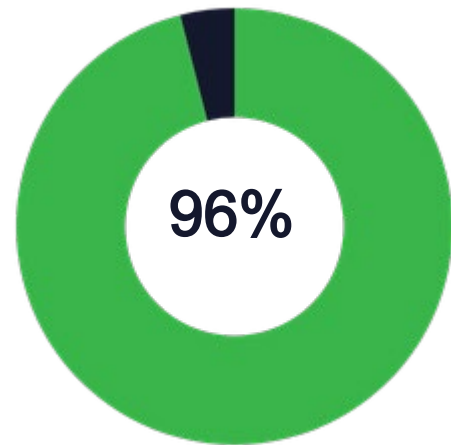

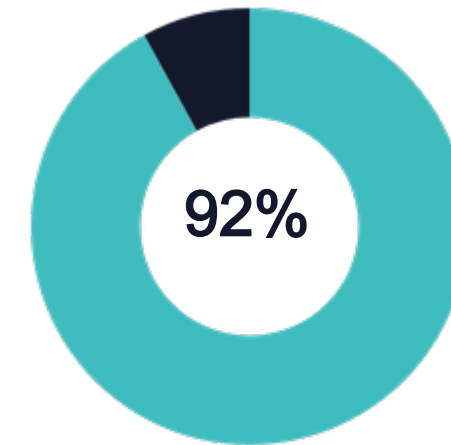

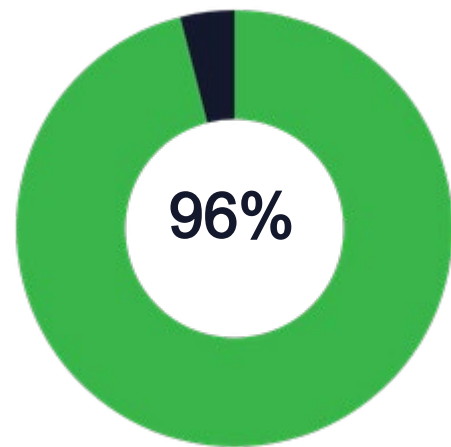

Do you feel your child has made a positive start at Bradfield School?



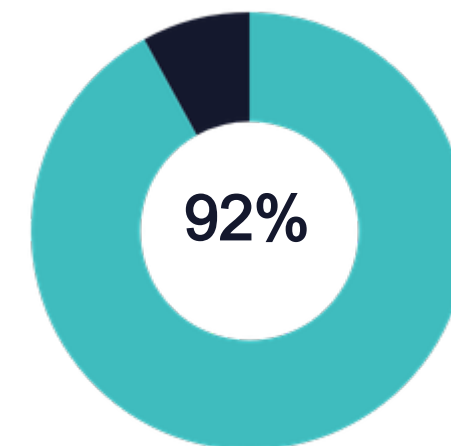

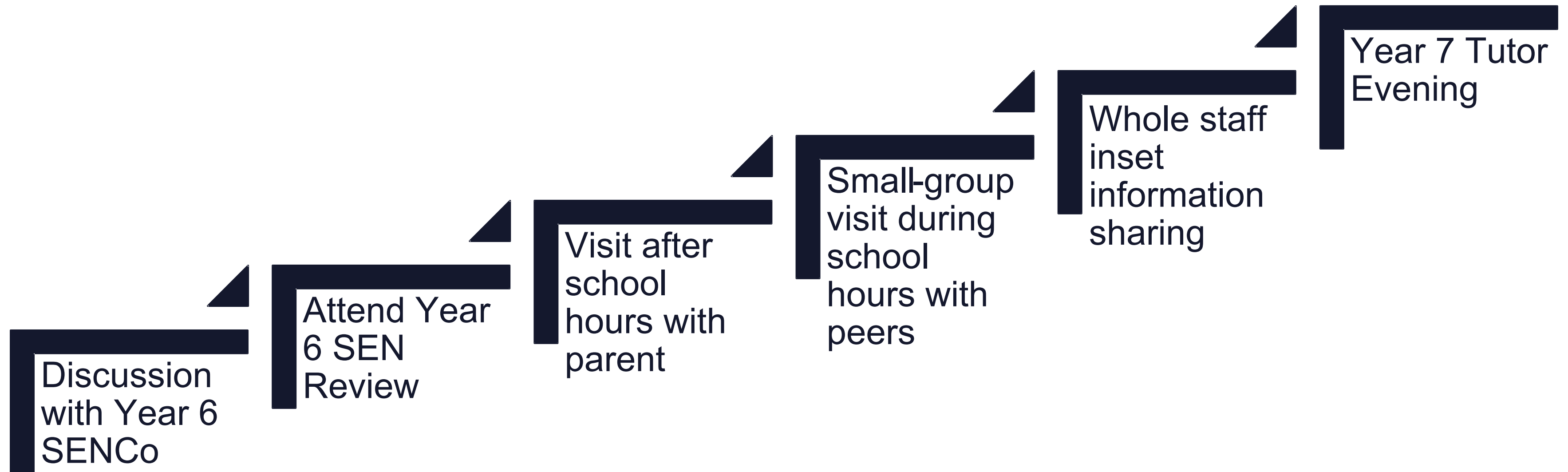
Form Groups

How do we support pupils with SEND with their transition?



Ordinarily Available Provision

- Unnecessary noise minimised.
- Consideration given to seating position.
- Word mats available to support vocabulary and spelling.
- Alternative forms to recording information.

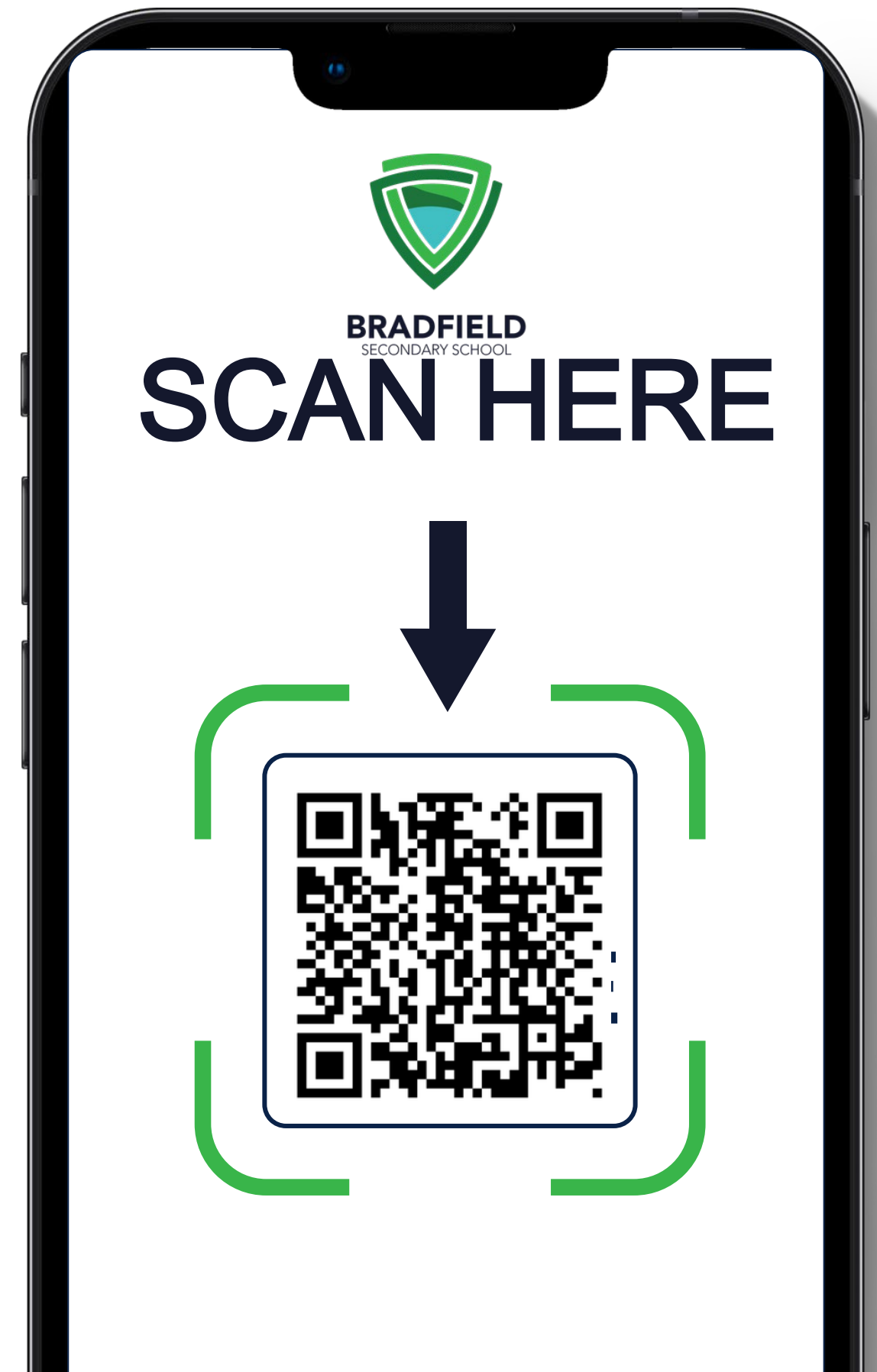
- Say students name to get attention.
- Allow time to process information.
- Say things in the order they will happen.
- Visual support used alongside verbal lesson content.

- Allow breaks between tasks and legitimate moving around activities.
- Prepare for changes.
- Use timers to measure and extend time on task.
- Match tasks with the young persons interests to increase engagement.

- Break tasks into manageable chunks.
- Use task plans and checklists to promote independent learning.
- Plan, teach and model techniques to the class.
- Give instructions simply and clearly.
