Summer School will take place on Wednesday 26th and Thursday 27th August from 10am – 2pm. Bradfield staff and external specialists will be running sessions across a range of curriculum areas, focussing on building relationships across the year group and allowing your child to feel more settled with the transition process.

Pupils will need to be at school from 9.45am for a 10am start. They will be met by Bradfield staff who will welcome them and direct them towards the main hall. Students will need to be picked up or make their own way home at 2pm, there will be no school buses available.

They will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with them as the canteen will not be open. If you are entitled to free school meals, please indicate this on the Microsoft form.

Due to the range of activities, we will be doing they will need to bring a bag with a pencil case and wear comfortable clothes including trainers.

Uniform is **not** required for summer school.
