<p><b>English</b></p>	<p>Revision topics: The assessment is on an Unseen text. Students should continue with their reading for pleasure homework to help prepare them for the assessment.</p> <p>Revision tasks: Reading comprehension</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask someone to ask you about the book/s you are reading e.g. what has happened? How has the writer described the setting?</li> <li>• Work through the critical reading activities on BBC Bitsize. <a href="#">Critical reading - KS3 English - BBC Bitesize</a></li> </ul>
<p><b>French</b></p>	<p>Revision topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Yellow Knowledge Organiser:</b> Introducing yourself with name, age, birthday; saying how many brothers and sisters you have; saying what you like and don't like</li> <li>• <b>Blue Knowledge Organiser:</b> Giving your opinion on school subjects and teachers, describing school uniform (including colours), describing the school building and facilities</li> <li>• <b>Green Knowledge Organiser:</b> Sports you play, hobbies you do, activities you do online and opinions</li> <li>• <b>Pink Knowledge Organiser:</b> Members of your family and physical descriptions, where you live, what you eat for breakfast, celebrating a festival</li> </ul> <p>Revision tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Download KOs from SatchelOne and RAG rate the units. Focus your revision on units you are not confident on, e.g. you may not need to revise brothers and sisters, but you might spend more time on sports</li> <li>• Make revision flashcards or mind maps and use the revision methods of look, cover, write, check</li> <li>• Ask someone to repeatedly test you on the vocabulary from the Knowledge Organisers.</li> </ul>
