Students should continue with their reading for pleasure homework to help prepare them for the assessment.</p> <p>Revision tasks: Reading comprehension:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ask someone to ask you about the book/s you are reading e.g. what has happened? How has the writer described the setting?2. - Work through the critical reading activities on BBC Bitsize Critical reading - KS3 English - BBC Bitesize

<p>French</p>	<p>Revision topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yellow Knowledge Organiser: Giving your opinion on free time activities; after school clubs; describing friends; what you did for a birthday party; what you did/wore last weekend • Blue Knowledge Organiser: Saying how you earn money (both activities like tidying your rooms, washing the car and things like having a YouTube channel and selling products); saying what job you want to do; describing your future plans • Green Knowledge Organiser / White Knowledge Organiser: Giving your opinion on a song and genres of music; describing what you did at a concert; saying if you play an instrument; giving your opinion on whether a celebrity is a good or a bad influence • Pink Knowledge Organiser: Saying what there is in a meal; saying what you don't/never eat and giving a view on veganism <p>Revision tasks:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Download KOs from SatchelOne and RAG rate the units. Focus your revision on units you are not confident on, e.g. you may not need to revise food, but you might spend more time on saying how you earn money 2. Make revision flashcards or mind maps and use the revision methods of look, cover, write, check 3. Ask someone to repeatedly test you on the vocabulary from the Knowledge Organisers.

Read through your notes from lessons on this topic. For each lesson in the topic try to write down what you think. The key idea of the lesson was 2. Look at your knowledge organiser for this topic and summarise the key information on it. You could try creating a flashcard for each key idea on it and use these to practice your knowledge 3. On your knowledge organiser there is a set of key vocabulary. Ensure you understand what each word means.
