Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you of the updated arrangements for our Year 9 end of year rewards visit, and to share some exciting details about the day.

Our original plan to visit Scarborough seaside sadly is no longer viable due to the lack of availability of coach transport during the final week of term. We understand this may come as a disappointment, but we are pleased to confirm an alternative that we believe offers a fun and rewarding day for students to celebrate their achievements this year.

The revised end of year visit will now take place in Sheffield city centre, where students will enjoy a morning at Cambridge Street Collective, followed by an afternoon at Lane 7 for bowling, pool, and arcade games.

*Details of the Day:*

- *Date of Visit: Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2025*
- *Start Time and Location: Meet at Cambridge Street Collective at 9:00am (11 Backfields, Sheffield S1 4HP)*
- *End Time and Location: Students will be dismissed from Lane 7, Sheffield at 2:30pm (Matilda St, Sheffield S1 4PF)*

Students will need to make their own way to the starting point (Cambridge Street Collective) and home from the end point (Lane 7). Both venues are in the centre of Sheffield and are easily accessible by public transport, including buses and trams. Staff will supervise a short walk of approximately 10 minutes between the two venues. Students are advised to wear comfortable clothing and footwear suitable for walking and taking part in activities. Cambridge Street Collective will be open to the public and your child may be amongst people who they do not know. We expect that students' behaviour will be exemplary. If there are any concerns during the visit, your child must inform a member of staff immediately. The toilets at Cambridge Street Collative are unisex. Whilst there are individual lockable cubicles, students are to speak to a member of staff if this is a worry or concern for them.

Food and Drink:

- A drink and croissant will be provided at Cambridge Street Collective as part of the visit.
- Students should bring their own packed lunch.
- Students eligible for free school meals will be provided with a 'grab bag' lunch, which will be organised by school.
- Drinks and snacks will also be available to purchase at both venues.


We always try hard to accommodate all students wishing to go on the trip but occasionally, if we are oversubscribed, we may have to turn students down.
