Curriculum

Our author of the half term is Micheal Rosen and our text is 'Growing Frogs' by Vivian French

In Geography we will learn the key features of a life cycle and identify 4

In RE our question is 'Where do we belong?'

In Art we will continue to use our sketch-books, explore line drawing, through observational drawing and from memory. We will return to and build on previous learning and refining our ideas .

In Music we will Listen actively to music in 3/4 time. Compose a three-beat body percussion pattern and perform it to a steady beat. Sing a melody in waltz time and perform the actions and transfer actions to sounds played on percussion instruments.
