### Curriculum

Our author of the half term is Atinuke and our text is 'Splash, Anna Hibiscus'

Our topic is 'Seaside' and we talk about the lives of the people around us linked to this and their roles in society.

In RE we will be learning all about 'What is special about our world?'

In Art we will continue to use our sketchbooks and explore the world making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants. We will revisit and practice previously learned skills and techniques linked to colour and tone.

In Music we will listen actively to music in 3/4 time. Compose a three-beat body percussion pattern and perform it to a steady beat. Sing a melody in waltz time and perform the actions. Transfer actions to sounds played on percussion instruments. Find the beat and perform a clapping game with a partner

We will continue to have weekly mental health session practicing and using the techniques we have learned this year during My Happy Mind.
