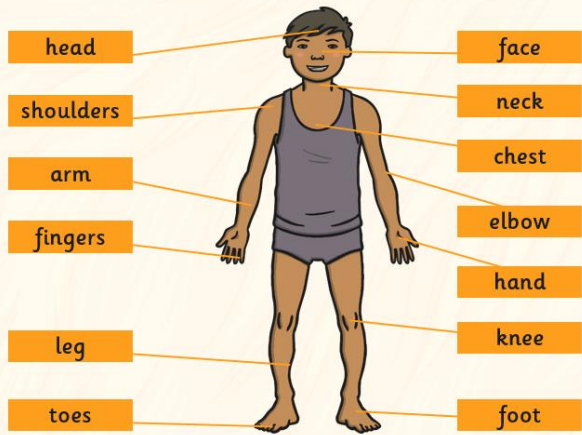

Human Body

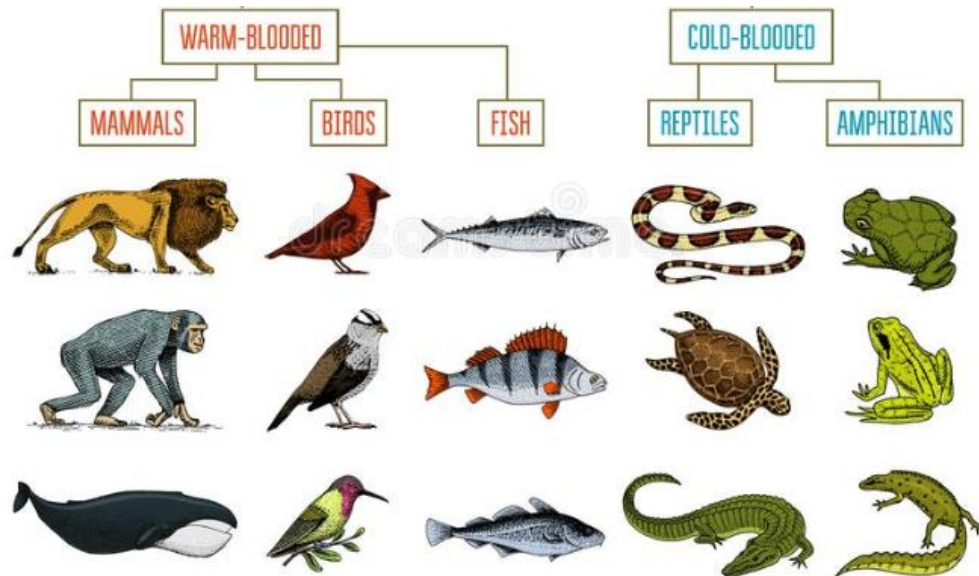
**Key Facts**

1. Animals can be sorted by type; mammal, fish, reptile, bird, amphibian
2. Animals can also be grouped by what they eat; carnivore, omnivore, herbivore
3. Humans have 5 senses; touch, taste, smell, sight and hearing
4. Humans are mammals

**Vocabulary**

Herbivore	An animal that eats plants
Omnivore	An animal that eats plants and animals
Carnivore	An animal that eats other animals
Mammals	Breathe air, grown hair or fur, feed on their mother's milk as babies
Fish	Breathe underwater through gills, have scaly skin
Reptiles	Breathe air, have scaly skin
Birds	Breathe air, lay eggs
Amphibians	live in the water as babies and on land as they get older
Sight	Your eyes let you see
Hearing	Your ears hear sounds
Touch	Your skin can tell if it is warm, cold, smooth or rough
Taste	Your tongue can tell if something is bitter or sweet
Smell	Your nose smells the scents around you
