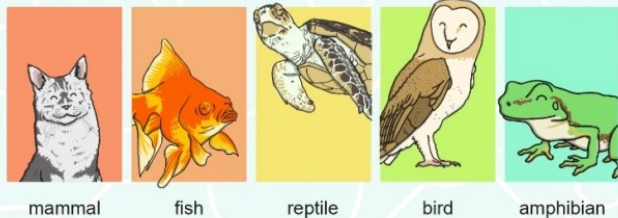
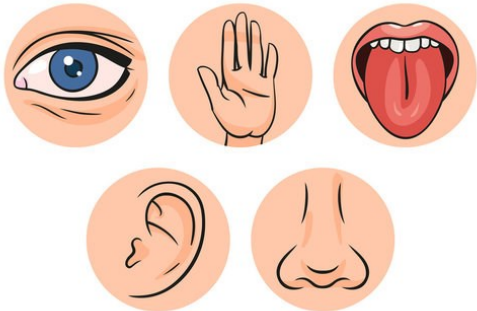
Key Information

Animals can be sorted by type; mammal, fish, reptile, bird, amphibian.

Animals can be grouped by what they eat; carnivore, omnivore, herbivore.

Humans have 5 senses; touch, taste, smell, sight and hearing.

Vocabulary

Amphibians	Live on water and on land. They have smooth
Birds	have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.
Fish	Live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and gills to breathe.
Mammals	Animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur, and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.
Reptiles	All reptiles breathe air, they have scales on their skin.
Carnivore	Animals that eat meat and other animals.
Herbivore	Animals that only eat plants.
Omnivore	Animals that eat both plants and meat or other
Senses	any of five ways to understand or experience surroundings. The senses are touch, smell, taste, sight, and hearing.
