A huge **thank you** to everyone who has really taken on board the message about keeping our families safe during drop off and pick up time. Our Junior PCSOs had to apply for their position and then had some training with our local GMP PCSOs Scott and Hannah. The children are really keen to make sure the school entrance and Bradley Green Road is safe for all who use it, so if you get an 'advisory notice' please make sure you read it and act on it. Next time, it could be an actual ticket. The law states that on the double yellow lines there is NO waiting at any time. If a driver has a disability badge, they can park on the double yellows, but we would hope they would still park considerately to both our neighbours and pupils wherever possible. Also on the single yellows outside school there is **NO** parking between the hours of 8.30am and 6pm. The yellow zig zags are also NO STOPPING between Mon-Fri 8am-5pm-this



includes no dropping children off, not using the school entrance as a turning point or dropping a child and parent off and one parent staying in the car. We urge parents to park further away from school to

keep our children safe and promote road safety.

We love using Class Dojo as a school to share the good things that are happening in our classes and I really appreciate the time staff take to



message parents to ensure you are kept up to date with what is happening. With that in mind, can I ask parents and carers to be mindful of the times they are messaging staff and the content of messages. Our staff leave school after a long day working with your children and then go home to their own families. Some messages recently have really upset staff. I will be urging staff to use 'quiet hours' on dojo which will mean your message won't appear to them until the 'quiet hours' have stopped. If you have a concern, I would encourage you to use the normal methods of communication, such as face to face or the telephone or use dojo to set up a meeting so we can ensure it is not something that is passed back and forth on dojo, as often messages can be easily misinterpreted. We want to keep using it as we know how powerful it is to be able to share the rewards and good work with parents, but I also urge you to consider the staff's well being regarding the sending of messages (both times and manner of them) Thank you for your continued support.
