<u>Attendance</u>

Our current overall attendance is **96.16%** - we would love it to be higher! It is really important you contact school as soon as you know your child is not going to be in school—either by ClassDojo or phoning the office—this will save you getting a phone call from school to ask where your child is. Remember any lates after 9.25am go down as an unauthorised absence (unless there is a reason like medical appointments etc) Please could you send a copy of any medical/dental appointment letters to the school office so they can be saved on your child's record. School work closely with the Education Welfare Officer to look at ways of improving attendance and also to challenge poor attendance.
