This prehistoric time is divided into the Stone Age, The Bronze Age and the Iron Age.</p>	<p>Stone Age people were hunter-gathers who used tool made out of stone, flint and antlers</p>	<p>The Stone Age people started to settle in one area and began to grow their food on farms.
