

Life cycle

A life cycle is a series of stages a living thing goes through during its life

Frogspawn

The eggs that frogs lay are called frogspawn. Frogspawn looks like a large clump of jelly. However it is, in fact, a collection of thousands of frog eggs stuck

Tadpole

A tadpole is a baby frog. Tadpoles are tiny round creatures with long tails and gills for breathing underwater.







Algae

Algae is a plant that grows and lives in water. Water creatures feed on algae.

Froglet

A froglet is the next stage of a frogs life cycle after a tadpole and is very nearly an adult frog.



Frogs are small animals that can jump very well. It can take 16 week for a frog to grow from frogspawn to an adult frog. Frogs live anywhere in the world except for very cold places.
