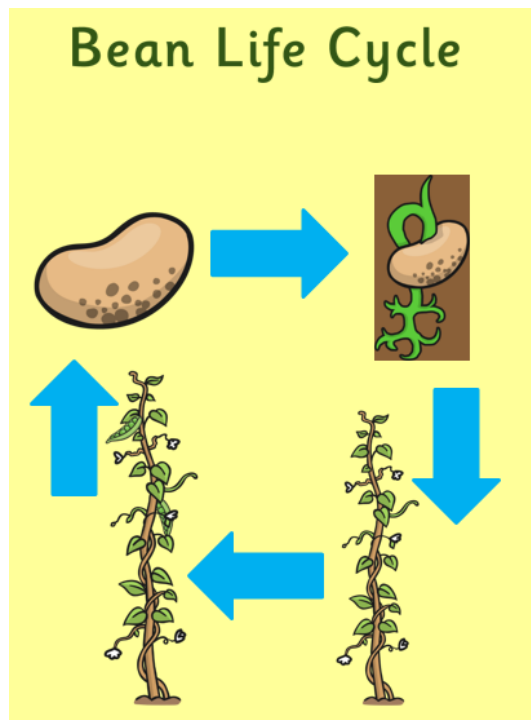

## Key Information

- 1 Spring** is one of the four seasons. It is a time when things start to grow.
- Plants need soil, water and light to grow.
- The **flower** of the plant is colourful so it attracts insects, which get the pollen from the flower and transport it to other flowers to help it make another plant.
- Weeds** are plants that are not wanted in the garden.
- There are many different types of bean, such as broad bean, baked bean, green bean, kidney bean, butter bean.
- Some of the tools we use when we are gardening are **trowels, forks** and **spades**.
- Fruit and vegetables** come from plants or are parts of plants.
- Remember **NO PICK, NO LICK!** Some plants can make us ill if we eat them and it will stop them growing.

## Vocabulary

<b>Bean</b>	An edible seed, typically kidney-shaped, growing in long pod
<b>Grow</b>	To increase in size.
<b>Roots</b>	A part of the plant which anchors it to the ground and sucks up water and nutrients.
<b>Leaf</b>	A leaf is attached to the stem or stalk. Leaves help the plant to make the food.
<b>Stem</b>	The main body or stalk of a plant.
<b>Flower</b>	The flower holds the seeds and is colourful to attract insects.
<b>Seed</b>	Can grown into a plant.
<b>Bud</b>	A growth on a plant that develops into a flower, shoot or
