

Vocabulary	
Port	A town or city with a harbour or access to navigable water where ships load or unload
Harbour	A place on the coast where ships park up
Tourists	a person who is travelling to or visiting a place for pleasure
Economy	the money that a country earns
Contour lines	lines on a map that show how steep the land is. The closer they are, the steeper the land
Climate	average weather conditions of a certain place
