Key Information
We need light in order to see things.
Darkness is the absence of light.
Smooth, shiny surfaces reflect light well.
Dull and dark surfaces do not reflect light well.
A shadow is formed when light is blocked.
To make a shadow big, move the object
closer to the light source.
To make a shadow smaller, move the object
further away from the light source.
Opaque objects make darker shadows than
translucent or transparent objects because
they block more light.
