## Uniform Reminder

It was fantastic to see so many smart children in assembly this week and around school. Just a reminder of the school uniform requirements.

- White shirt or white polo shirt
- Grey trousers/skirt/smart shorts in summer
- Forest green cardigan/jumper/sweatshirt
- Forest green/white check summer dress
- Sensible and safe black footwear for outdoors
- White, black or grey socks
- Grey, black or forest green tights

## Outdoor PE

When possible we will be using the outdoors for games PE so it would be great if you could supply your child with a pair of black jogging bottoms (from £4 in Asda) and a light pac a mac waterproof (approx. £5 on Amazon)

We do not allow children to wear jeans, jewellery (other than a simple watch/fitbit style watch without a camera or stud earrings which must be removed for PE), football kits or anything with words/pictures that may cause offence.

Neither should any form of make up including nail varnish or hair dye be used.

Please ensure hair bows etc are small and discrete not large and distracting. Please also write or label your child's jumpers and cardigans with their name—you wouldn't believe how many we've already had go missing or left behind!
