This term ...

Our topic this term will have a Geography focus will be learning all about volcanoes and earthquakes. We will be learning the location of the volcanoes and discovering why some places experience earthquakes and others don't. We will also find out how volcanoes are formed and how earthquakes happen. The children will also consider how they impact on the population of a place.

In art we will be learning and experimenting with different collage techniques.

In ICT we will be learning how to use technology safely. They will consider how to stay safe online and how to recognize potential dangers.

Our science topic we will be exploring states of matter, we will be learning about the three states of matter and identifying the state of everyday materials. The children will have the opportunity to investigate solids, liquids and gases and carry out experiments.

## How you can help

MATHS This half term will focus on place value, rounding and Roman numerals. Progressing on to addition and subtraction. There will also be a big focus on the learning of times table and division facts. We will be using TT Rock stars which will be happening daily, this will help the children to rapidly recall their times table and division facts. The children will have a daily times table test in Year 4 please help them to practice the times table they are working on.

ENGLISH Across the school we will be studying a beautiful picture book by Oliver Jeffers called 'Here we are' We will then begin our class text which will be the 'The Firework Maker's daughter'

The book will develop both our reading and writing skills. The children will also have handwriting and spelling and grammar lessons throughout the week.
