#### This term ...

Our topic this term will have a history focus will be learning all about prehistoric Britain and the ancient Britons. We will be learning about the three key time periods: The Stone Age, The Bronze Age and The Iron Age. We will be considering how people lived during these periods. We will be looking at how the discovery of new materials changed the lives of people.

Our art topic links with our history theme, we will be developing our drawing techniques, we will be using different media to create drawings in the style of cave paintings.

In ICT we will be learning how to use technology safely. They will consider how to stay safe online and how to recognize potential dangers. We will also developing our digital literacy skills using Microsoft word.

Our science topic we will be exploring rocks and soils, we will be learning about the different properties of various rocks. The children will have the opportunity to investigate, observe, and experiment with different kinds of rocks.

MATHS This half term will focus on place value before we move on to addition and subtraction. There will also be a big focus on the learning of times table and division facts. We will be using TT Rock stars which will be happening daily, this will help the children to rapidly recall their times table and division facts. The children will have a daily timed times table test in Year 3 please help them to practice the times table they are working on.
