<u>MATHS</u> This half term we begin with negative numbers and Roman numerals Progressing on to addition and subtraction and then units of work focusing on multiplication and . There will also be a big focus on the learning of times table and division facts. We will be using TT Rock stars which will be happening daily, this will help the children to rapidly recall their times table and division facts. The children will have a daily times table test in Year 4 please help them to practice the times table they are working on.

ENGLISH Our new English text is Escape from Pompeii by Christina Ballitt. The story will help us develop knowledge of life for the Romans and the volcano Mount Vesuvius. In lessons we will develop both our reading and writing skills. The children will also have handwriting and spelling and grammar lessons throughout the week.
