This half term our teaching and learning will focus on life cycles as we explore the text “Yucky worms” which encompasses both fiction and non-fiction. We are going to become wormologists and learn so many new things about worms! We will learn about how helpful worms can be and will make our own wormery.

In our Forest School sessions, we will continue to show respect to nature and each other. We will go on minibeast hunts and use natural materials to recreate work by Andy Goldsworthy.

Our work in Drawing club, is going from strength to strength. We will continue to learn new vocabulary and explore different stories and animations from the past.

We will continue with weekly Sing up music sessions and our focus will be “I’ve got feelings”.

We move onto a new module “Engage” in our My Happy Mind sessions. Engage explores perseverance, challenge and how we can set goals.

In Maths, we will focus on numbers 7 and 8, 2d and 3 shapes and further develop our subitising skills.

Our author of the half term is Eric Carle and we will learn that he wrote and illustrated many children’s books.

In Phonics, we will start our Read, Write Inc set 1 sounds. I will be posting videos on how we pronounce the pure sounds and children will be taking home a letter formation sheet, on a daily basis.
