Curriculum

Our author of the half term is Emily Gravett and our text is Hello friend by Rebecca Corbet

In Geography we will be learning all about the school grounds, aerial photographs and exploring what jobs people do in our community.

In History we will be looking at the differences between people and families.

In Science we will be learning about Autumn and look at the seasonal changes.

In RE we will be learning all about 'Which people are special and why?'

In Art we will be introducing sketchbooks, exploring pencil drawing and colour mixing. We will be looking at the work of Henri Matisse and practicing the technique of pointillism.

In Music we will make up new words and actions about different emotions and feelings. Explore making sound with our voices to create different feelings and moods.
