Curriculum

Our author of the half term is Jessica Souhami and our text is 'Blue Penguin' and 'The Leopard's drum'

In Geography we will be learning where hot and cold countries are using a world map and beginning to learn what the seven continents are. We will also start to recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and other countries

In RE we will be learning all about Which places are special and why?

In Art we will continue to use our sketchbooks, explore line drawing, through observational drawing and from memory. We will print and explore shape linked to the images used in our text.

In Music we will explore the range and capabilities of voices through vocal play. And develop a sense of beat by performing actions to music. We will continue to enjoy moving freely and expressively to music. We will then go on to create a sound story using instruments to represent different animal sounds/ movements.
