Curriculum

In **English**, we will be reading the epic Anglo-Saxon poem Beowulf. We will be using this to create our own Anglo-Saxon mythical tales and newspaper reports

In **Maths**, we will be learning about multiplication and division words problems as well as learning some new things about fractions

In **History** will be learning all about the Anglo-Saxons! We will be learning about why they came to Britain, Alfred the Great, law and order and what effect they have had on modern Britain

In Science we will be learning about space

In **DT** we are going to be designing our very own cars that will run by using robotics

Homework

Maths homework on paper

Children will receive Maths homework each week on a Monday. The homework will be set on paper. Dojo points will be added for those children who complete this homework on time.



Reading

Children need to read their book to develop fluency. In school we will aim to read as much as possible with children but reading at home is very important too. Logging children's reading on BoomRead (formerly GoRead) helps us track this and give out dojos.
