

EYFS Knowledge Organiser: Seaside Term: Summer Term 2



Beach

A beach is a narrow, gently sloping strip of land that lies along the edge of the shore.



Shore

Shore is the part of the beach where the water moves.



Cliff

A cliff is a steep rock face at the edge of the sea.



Pier

A pier is a platform reaching out to sea that can be walked on and ships can pull up to.



Shells

A shell is a hard, protective outer covering for marine animals, like mollusks and sea urchins.



Rockpools

Rockpools are small pools of seawater that form along the beach and are a home to many sea creatures.



Lifeguard

Lifeguards look after swimming areas, help swimmers to stay safe and carry out rescues in emergencies.



Tide

Tide the water level of the sea. High tide = sea close to the beach. Low tide = sea is far away.
