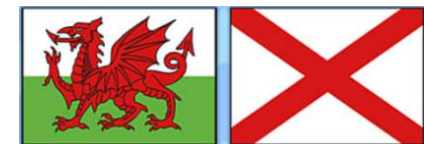
Vocabulary

Physical Feature	Any naturally occurring geographical feature such as a lake or mountain
Human Feature	Any man-made feature such as Buckingham Palace or a Stadium
Landmark	A feature that is easily recognisable
Capital City	The city that functions as the seat of government for the country
National Symbol	An image or object that represents that country
National Day	A date on which a country celebrates
Patron Saint	A person that is celebrated for their historical actions

1. The United Kingdom is made up of four countries; England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.
2. The capital city of England is London.
3. St George is the patron saint of England and is celebrated on the 23<sup>rd</sup> April.
4. The national animal of England is the lion.
5. The capital city of Northern Ireland is Belfast.
6. St Patrick's Day is celebrated in Northern Ireland on the 17<sup>th</sup> March.
7. The national symbol of Ireland is the shamrock.
8. The capital city of Scotland is Edinburgh.
9. St Andrew's Day is celebrated in Scotland on the 30<sup>th</sup> November.
10. The national symbol of Scotland is the thistle.
11. The capital city of Wales is Cardiff.
12. St David's Day is celebrated in Wales on the 1<sup>st</sup> March.
13. The national symbol of Wales is the daffodil.
