Sanatana Dharma'	For Hindus, following sanatana dharma means living their lives in such a way that they are always considering their moral choices and making the best decisions they can. They should also worship and pray so that they are thinking about God.
Deities	Trimurti, (Sanskrit: "three forms") in Hinduism, triad of the three gods Brahma, Vishnu, and Shiva.
Puja	puja usually consists of making an offering of flowers or fruit to an image of a god.
punusharthas	Dharma: religious or moral duty; Artha: providing for family and society by honest means; Kama: regulated enjoyment of the pleasures and beauty of life; Moksha: liberation from the cycle of birth and rebirth; reincarnation.
Temple / Mandir	Mandirs are centres for the community and worship
Mahatma Gandhi	Within his country, he supported the rights of both Hindus and Muslims. He also sought better treatment for groups everyone else looked down upon. He used peaceful protests,
