Anglican	Church of England. Protestant branch of Christianity.
Baptist	Belief that followers of Jesus should be baptised
Synagogue	Jewish place of worship known as 'house of assembly' (a place to get together)
Schul	Another name for synagogue meaning school 'a place to learn'
Pilgrimage	A special journey made for religion or beliefs.
Deity	A deity or god is a supernatural being considered divine or sacred. Deities can also be represented through statues or images.
Shrine	A holy or sacred site dedicated to a specific deity, where they are worshipped.

Wailing Wall	The <i>Western Wall in Jerusalem</i> is a holy place of prayer and <i>pilgrimage</i> sacred to the <i>Jewish</i> people.
Kumbh Mela	The most famous Hindu pilgrimage is the Kumbh Mela, which takes place at the River Ganges in India. Up to 40 million people come to purify themselves in the water, the biggest gathering of people on Earth. There are many different places for Hindus to go on pilgrimage. Rivers, mountains and temples linked to different gods and goddesses are all popular places to visit. Hindus try to do at least one pilgrimage in their lifetime.
Synagogue	A synagogue is a place of worship, gathering and education about the Jewish faith. Synagogues can also be used for community centres.
Fresh Expression of Church	Fresh Expressions of Church are alternate Christian communities. They take several different forms, such as Messy Church, New Monastic Communities, Cafe Church or Alternative Worship to name but a few.
