<b>Genesis</b>	The First book in the Bible. Christians believe this is the story of how the earth was created.
<b>Christian key belief</b>	Christians believe that humans were made in the image of God.
<b>Code for living</b>	A personal system of beliefs, rules and morals.
<b>Humanist</b>	Humanists do not believe in a god. They believe it is possible to live a good and fulfilling life without following a traditional religion.  They do not follow a holy book either. Instead, Humanists value traits like reason and rely on science to explain the way things are.
<b>Do Humanists worship?</b>	Humanists do not have a regular place of worship. They do, however, hold talks, lectures and discussion groups all around the country.  Humanist also have ceremonies, celebrations or special occasions. Many Humanists hold naming ceremonies, non-religious weddings and funerals.

<b>Christian</b>	Christians believe there is only one God, but that he is revealed in three different forms; God the Father, God the Son and The Holy Spirit.

### Main Beliefs of Humanism

<u>Non-Existence of Gods</u> Most <b>Humanists</b> are <b>atheists</b> . They rely on science and have found no evidence that a god exists or ever existed.	<u>Meaning of Life</u> <b>Humanists</b> give their lives meaning by living good lives. They make good choices and take an interest in the world around them.	<u>Science</u> Scientific investigations gather evidence to find the truth. <b>Humanists</b> also use evidence to see what is true.
<u>No Purpose to the Universe</u> They believe that the universe was created by chance, so there is no purpose to the universe.	<u>Reason</u> <b>Humanists</b> believe decisions should not be made on emotions, but on reason, <b>rationality</b> and logic.	<u>Ethical Decisions</u> To live good lives, decisions must be weighed up for their positive and negative consequences for all. <b>Humanists</b> believe there are no perfect decisions.
