
<u>Curriculum</u>

In English, we will be finishing exploring Shackleton's journey. We will be beginning our History topic of the Mayans this half -term, linking with one of our English texts 'Rain Player'. We have some superb opportunities to develop our Historian skills and knowledge as well as apply this to our writing.

Our author of the half term is Benjamin Zephaniah, author of texts such as: Windrush child, Refugee boy and People need people.
