## <u>Curriculum</u>

We will be beginning our Geography topic this half-term, looking at 'rivers'. We will be investigating the journey of a river, flooding, the impacts of flooding on the local community as well as using our map skills on a trip to the Tame River.

In Science, we will be looking at the circulatory system and evolution, with lots and lots of opportunities to work scientifically!

Our Art topic this half-term is 'brave art'. The children will be becoming more independent with their creative choices and we look forward to showing you our learning in July.
