This term ...

<u>History</u>

We will be learning about the Gunpowder Plot. We will be finding out about why the Gunpowder Plot occurred, who was involved, how it was stopped, and why we still celebrate Bonfire Night.

<u>English</u>

We will be reading 'The Snail and the Whale' – a story about a snail who wants to explore the world with a whale and then goes on to save the day!

Our focus author for the term is Julia Donaldson.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be focusing on place value and addition and subtraction within 10.

<u>Science</u>

We will be investigating seasonal changes. Why the weather changes and what weather is typically associated with each season.

Computing

We will be looking at how to stay safe on line and to be a good digital citizen. We will also be exploring algorithms, what they are and how we can create our own.

<u>Art</u>

We will be looking at the work of Kandinsky and exploring colour through the use of paint.



How you can help:

Reading

Reading books will be sent home regularly and this is a key focus for all children.
