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How you can help:

Reading

Reading books will be sent home regularly and this is a key focus for all children.

Every child that reads and returns their book will receive 3 dojo points and be able to move their 'reading rocket' across the chart. For every 20 books read, children will receive a prize!

This term ...

Geography

We will be learning about the United Kingdom. We will be finding out about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and about the seas that surround our islands.

English

Reading

We are continuing to progress through the Green Read, Write Inc. scheme.

To support your child at home, please practice as often as possible with the common exception words and high frequency words.

The reading text that is provided within the homework book is the same text that has been studied in school and so the children should be confident at reading this. The red words highlighted are the tricky common exception words.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be finishing off out work on addition and subtraction within 10, before moving onto look at addition and subtraction within 20.

To support your child, please can you practice number bonds for 10 as often as possible.

Computing

We will be looking in more depth into algorithms and moving onto using laptops.

Snack

Children have regular access to a water fountain within the classroom, in addition to receiving a piece of fruit daily.

<u>Uniform</u>

To reduce the likelihood of your child losing their clothing. Please make sure that every piece of your child's school uniform is clearly labelled.

Please can you ensure that long hair is tied back and that only stud earrings are worn in school.
