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This term ...

<u>History</u>

We will be continuing to learn about Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake as part of our space topic.

<u>English</u>

We will be reading 'Man on the Moon: A day in the life of Bob' – a story about Bob. A man who goes to work every day on the moon.

<u>Reading</u>

We are continuing to progress through the new Read, Write Inc. scheme.

To support your child at home, please practice as often as possible with the common exception words and high frequency words provided in the Phonics Packs.

<u>Maths</u>

We are continuing to look at place value within 50 before moving onto measurement (length, height, mass, weight, capacity and volume)

To support your child, please can you practice number bonds for 10, counting to 100 and multiple addition of 2's, 5's and 10's as often as possible.

How you can help:

<u>Reading</u>

Reading books will be sent home regularly and this is a key focus for all children.

Every child that reads and returns their book will receive 5 dojo points and be able to move their 'reading rocket' across the chart. For every 10 books read, children will receive a prize!

HOMEWORK

Homework will consist of spellings, English and Maths – linked to the work we are doing in school. This will be sent home on Tuesday and needs to be back in school by the following Monday. Children are expected to present their homework neatly.

We will be continuing to use the laptops for basic computer skills, in addition to re-visiting coding.
