We continue back with our addition and subtraction learning in maths. Last half term, we were building on a range of strategies. This half term we will look closely at the formal column method, making one or more exchange. Following this, we will move to multiplication and division.

In English we will be reading book 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman. This will cross curricular link to our geography topic of volcanoes. We will writing formal letters, character descriptions and journals. If your child has a copy at home, they are very welcome to bring it into school and read long in the English lessons.

Our main topic is, 'What makes the Earth tremor?' We will have a strong geography focus this half term. We will be starting with volcanoes, then moving our focus to earthquakes. We will be using and developing our mapping skills, making comparisons about where live, and researching case study countries such as Japan.

In Science we will be investigating sound. We have lots of practical investigations planned, and will be using decibel readers to measure the sound levels around school!

For PSHE we will be focusing on our core value of respect. In the classroom we will be thinking of the different ways that we can show respect. We will also be thinking about how can we respect and understand different groups of people.

In art we will complete our mosaics, I know the children have been looking forward to this! After that, we will be starting our new topic which is painting. We will be looking at the work of Jackson Pollock this half term.

I hope to have Parent's Evening rescheduled soon. I will keep the original time slots. I will post a list of times onto class story this week. Any problems or questions, please let me know.

Finally – Spelling tests will take place on a Friday, and times tables tests throughout the week. We will send spellings home every Monday.
