<u>Dates</u>

Curriculum

In **English**, we will be reading a story about a Tenzing Norgay and Edmund Hillary's expedition up Everest in 1953

In **Science** we will be learning about different materials and how they can dissolve in water or not

Maths homework on SUMDOG

Children will receive Maths homework each week on a Monday. The homework will be set on Sumdog. Dojo points will be added for those children who complete this homework on time.



Reading

Children need to read their book to develop fluency. In school we will aim to read as much as possible with children but reading at home is very important too. Logging children's reading on BoomRead (formerly GoRead) helps us track this and give out dojos.
