## Maths

This term we will be starting back with area, using our knowledge of multiplication. We will then be moving on to fractions, building on prior knowledge from year 4 and taking it further with adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators and multiplying proper and mixed fractions by whole numbers.

# **English**

We have now finished the international yeti collective and are moving on to 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell. This new text will provide us with lots of writing opportunities. Through this text we will be looking at a range of poetic styles, persuasive writing, letter writing, and narrative writing to name a few of our writing opportunities.

#### **Homework**

Our science topic, which we will be starting towards the end of this half term and continuing with in Spring 2, is all about life process of plants and mammals. This links quite nicely to our geography topic as we have an opportunity to explore plants and animals that inhabit the Amazon Rainforest.
