Our electric security gates are now fully working and operating to ensure the safety of our pupils.

Please be patient with us as the timings may need adjusting after a trial period. Currently the opening times are as follows for the pedestrian gates:

8.25—9.00am

11.20-11.40am

12.05-12.30pm

3.05-3.30pm

4.05-4.40pm

Please note when using the gates at times not listed you will need to buzz for entry and exit and someone in school will pick up. When leaving the premises at the times listed, just pull the gate open

All vehicles using the school drive need to request access and unless you hold a disability blue badge or are a delivery, you will be asked to park a safe distance away from school and use the pedestrian entrance.
