Curriculum

In **English** we will be reading a lovely story by Satoshi Kitamura, called the Stone Age Boy. This book links really well with our Ancient Britons topic and will help us to learn more about life in the prehistoric times.

In **Maths** we will be learning to multiply and divide and developing our fraction knowledge. We will also be revisiting some previously taught objectives to ensure we are remembering our learning.

In **History** we will complete our learning about 'Were the historic Britons that different to us?' They will be considering the similarities and differences between themselves and prehistoric people.

In **Geography** we will be learning about our local communities and how we can help support the local community
