- The photos of the children are now on the board in the hall.
- The children came to the meeting with some questions and suggestions.
- They would like to know if the bridge on the trim trail is going to be replaced. I have explained that it will be very expensive to replace and that children have not looked after it so it may not be possible to have it replaced or fixed.
- The children have asked for some more items at lunch time: dolls, hula hoops, skipping ropes, cricket bats and wickets, basketballs, skittles and bowls, crates, whiteboards, badminton, creative tables, toy cars, colours and some more of the new spinning seats that school have bought recently.
- At lunchtimes, each year group is given very short time slots for the football area – the children would like to know if they could have just two different year groups per day so that each year group gets around 30 minutes for their session. They would also like to have a maximum number of children playing at a time as its difficult to play with too many children on the pitch.
- Some children have asked for an afternoon break but I explained that we finish at 3:15pm so the afternoon is short and we have to have a certain amount of time in class.
- The children would like a wider variety of sports during their PE sessions.
- Classes have asked for more school trips. I have explained that they need to speak to their teachers who can organise trips linked to the curriculum.
- Some children have also asked for more library time –this also needs to be discussed with their class teachers.
- There have been lots of requests for a new school librarian!
- Children have asked for more religious celebrations in school. I know Miss Lowe has arranged some visitors of different faiths to come into school and talk to the children so that is something to look forward to.
- There has been a request for some after school clubs: Art Club, Karate Club and Boxing Club if there are any teachers who would like to run them.
- Children have asked if they can have cereal bars on the trolley. I will ask the office if we can order a few packets to see how they sell.
- The classes in KS2 have asked if they could have some more footballs – I have told them that they need to be careful and make sure that they don't kick them out of the yard.
