- The children asked if the bridge on the trim trail will be repaired. At the moment it is working well as it is as the children are using the bar for hanging and are enjoying it.
- Children have asked for dolls, crafting tables, small toy trains, foam frisbees, a large whiteboard, skittles/bowling, spinning seats, netballs for the hoops, stacking crates and more hula hoops for OPAL.

- The children have asked if Mr Leyland can run a Minecraft club, which I believe is being set up.
- I have emailed classes asking their children to have some questions for Mr Connor next week regarding PE and sports.
