- In 2017, Mrs Rehman, set up her charity and named it after Hajjah Naziha (a charity worker), who inspired her because of all of her outstanding work and also because not only is she a woman, but a Muslim too, like herself.
- She told the children that although she was in charge of HNCO, she worked alongside and supported many other charities.
- With the money that Bradley School has raised, she will be arranging to feed families in poor villages in Pakistan and Kenya. They will be provided with non-perishables such as: rice, flour, oil, lentils etc. Kenya, however, will receive some meat too as it is quite difficult/expensive to get hold of.
- HNCO have supported many countries including: Pakistan, Kenya, Turkey, Sudan and Ukraine.
- They have also helped many countries that have been hit by natural disasters.
- Not only do HNCO work with countries around the world, they also support many people in the UK, from prisons to homeless shelters to refugees for women.
- The charity has many teams of people located in countries around the world. They also have teams in the UK, who travel to countries needing aid and support.
- The children really enjoyed asking questions and were very impressed with all the work that the charity does.
- They have created a power point which will be added to the school website.
