The following points were discussed:

- The Digital Leaders have been asking if Mr Smith will be restarting Digital Leaders Club – I believe it is restarting next week.
- Children have been complaining about Wifi connection in school. I have spoken to Mr Smith and he has informed me that our download speed will be significantly increased at the end of March.
- Many of the home reading books in KS2 are old, tatty and outdated so the children would like to know if school can purchase some new ones.
- Are there any plans to refurbish and heat the school bus? The children really miss their sessions on there.
- Some children have asked if Mad Science will be visiting school again. I have spoken to Miss Quadri and she said that this is something we can look at in the new school year when we will return to whole school mixing.

- Mrs Ishfaq has updated the lunchtime board in the hall with all the lunch staff on it as well as some quotes provided by the school council.
- The children would like to know if they could have some new wet play games.
- Will school be holding a summer fair this year to include the community or will it be run like last year?
- The children would like to know if they can dress up at the end of their theme/topic. I have told the children that this would be up to their class teachers as long as they put it past Mr Hull first.
- The children are going to ask their classes about school lunches: what they like, what they don't like, what they think needs changing, anything they want to see return on the menu and anything else they can think of. I will ask Ali to attend the next meeting.
- Are there any funds yet for the trim trail to be repaired?
