Severe Weather Conditions

During the winter months, we do everything we can to ensure that the children, parents and staff are safe around school.

Should there be snow or icy conditions, our site supervisor and Headteacher liaise to ensure that the premises can be made safe for the children to attend. During snow or ice, we will clear a path from the main gate on Dover Street into school and, if possible, a pathway across the main playground at the rear of school. We will regularly check that these pathways are useable and keep a close eye on weather conditions.

On the rare occasions that we feel it is safer to close the school, you will receive a text message as early as possible. Please ensure that we have up-to-date telephone numbers so that you don't miss this text. The closure will also be posted on our website and Facebook page. The children now need to have a warm coat with them every day for playtime, and hats and gloves if it is cold. Children may walk to school in their wellies or boots, but please send in school shoes for the children to wear in school.

Now that the clocks have gone back, it is dark by 4pm. As such, all of our children need to be collected by an adult after clubs. No children will be allowed to walk home alone.
