

How can you enrich your child's learning?

There a lot you can do as a parent to help your children with their learning:



Maths

- ✓ The children will be given times tables and other number facts to practise and learn at home.

Reading

- ✓ Your child will have an appropriate reading book to take home twice weekly (Monday and Thursday).
- ✓ Reading at home should be done every day.

If you have any concerns, or need any information, we are available to speak to you after school. Alternatively, you can ring up and make an appointment to speak to your child's teacher.

Things to remember for Year 2

PE kit

Maths

- Adding and subtracting
- Finding 10 more and 10 less.
- Multiplying and dividing by 2, 5, 10 and 3.
- Money - recognising the coins and how to make amounts of money.
- Shape - 2d and 3d shapes.
- Time - to 5 minute intervals
